- 2023 24 Hunting Trapping Seasons Approved (see attached "report" for details)
 - Archery season for Elk opens one week later
 - Crow Season adjusted by adding Thursdays
 - No major changes with whitetail or turkey; continue with Saturday opener to the firearms deer season
 - Increase in Antlerless deer licenses
 - No applications will be done by mail (pink envelopes are gone)
 - Hunting License to be purchased on line and at issuing agents beginning on Monday, June 26th this year for PA residents
 - Non-residents can purchase a hunting license beginning Monday, July 10th this year
 - DMAP permits will begin on Monday. August 14th this year
